## **Fact Sheet of Championships**

### **1. Title of Event**

“EUBC European Schoolboys Boxing Championships Dublin 2013”.

### **2. Competition Period**

- Championships Period: July 28 – August 04, 2013
- Competition Period: July 29 – August 03, 2013
- Arrivals: July 28, 2013
- Departures: August 4, 2013

### **3. Daily Competition and Meeting Schedule**

**4. Competition Venue**

- Name: City West Hotel
- Location: City West, Dublin

**5. Eligibility of Boxer and Weight Category**

A. Boxers who were born between January 1, 1999 – December 31, 2000 are eligible to participate (ages 13 - 14).

B. The Championships will be staged in 18 Weight Categories:  
38,5kg, 40kg, 41,5kg, 43kg, 44,5kg, 46kg, 48kg, 50kg, 52kg, 54kg, 56kg,  
59kg, 62kg, 65kg, 68kg, 72kg, 76kg, 76+kg

**6. Number of Rounds**

Three (3) rounds of three (1,5) minutes, one (1) minute rest between rounds.

**7. Scoring System**

New AIBA Scoring System will be used.



## 8. Referees & Judges

All Referees & Judges (1,2 and 3 AIBA Stars only) will be appointed by their respective National Federation.

## 9. Registration

### A. Boxers:

- AIBA National Member Federations can send only one (1) boxer in each weight category
- One (1) reserve boxer per weight category may be entered in the final registration
- It is also permissible for a nation to substitute one (1) boxer for another at any time up to the close of the General Weigh-In and the Medical Examination, provided that the substitute boxer has been entered as a reserved one for that weight category or any other weight category
- All other cases of substitution shall be finalized the day before the General Weigh-In.

### B. Number of Team Officials:

- Each team can have the following number of officials in its delegation:
  - 1 - 4 boxers: 2 coaches (1 AIBA 3-Star) + 1 R&J AIBA 1-2-3 Star
  - 5 - 8 boxers: 3 coaches (1 AIBA 3-Star) + 1 R&J AIBA 1-2-3 Star
  - 9 - 18 boxers: 4 coaches (1 AIBA 3-Star) + 1 R&J AIBA 1-2-3 Star
- All coaches must have the AIBA certification which EUBC will check at the time of registration as without the AIBA certification, they will not be allowed to enter this event
- In addition, each team may be accompanied by one (1) Team Manager, one (1) team doctor and one (1) physiotherapist
- Only coaches and boxers will be allowed to enter the boxers' locker rooms.

## 10. Requirements

### A. All Boxers must bring to the General Weigh-In the following documents:

- Boxer's AIBA Competition Record Book with annual medicals duly completed
- Passport
- Accreditation Card



B. Each Team Delegation (every participating country) must bring the following:

- National flag 1x 1.50m
- National anthem (on MP3 or CD)

C. Boxer's Uniform:

- Each boxer must bring two sets of uniform – red and blue
- All uniforms must follow the AIBA uniform guidelines in the Rules.

## 11. **Boxing Equipment**

The LOC will provide AIBA approved and licensed boxing gloves (WESING), headguards and hand bandages for all boxers and all bouts. Both boxing gloves and headguards are compulsory official items which all boxers must wear as they will not be allowed to wear their personal ones.

## 12. **Transportation**

A. Airport or Railway Station Reception:

- All participants will be welcomed at Dublin International Airport.

B. Ground Transportation:

- There will be a welcome desk to guide all teams to the ground transportation
- The LOC will provide local transportation between Hotel, Competition Venue and Training Venue(s) during the Championships Period
- The LOC will also provide local transportation for all departures

## 13. **Accommodation for Team Delegations**

A. Room Rates for Team Delegations are as follows:

- For single occupancy (1 person per room)
  - 105 Euros per person, per day, including 3 meals
- For double occupancy (2 persons per room)
  - 70 Euros per person, per day, including 3 meals
- For triple occupancy (3 people per room, the 3<sup>rd</sup> person sleeps on a fold out bed)
  - 65 Euros per person, per day, including 3 meals



**B. Payment of Hotel Room Charges:**

- All delegations must present the full room charges payment at the time of registration.

- On arrival, the team delegations must present the full payment for the entire Championships period
- Delegations will not be allowed to receive accreditations and hotel room keys if they do not clear the payment of full hotel room charges first.

**C. Check-In and Check-Out:**

- The room rates provided for the competition only apply from July 28 until August 04, 2013
- Team Delegations choosing to arrive earlier and/or stay longer than the Championships Period must pay a room rate of 90 Euros per person, per day, including 3 meals in double room
- and 120 Euros per person, per day, including 3 meals in single room

**D. Extra Team Officials:**

- No Extra Team Official is allowed to stay at the Team Delegation Hotel
- LOC assistance can only be given in finding rooms in a different hotel than the Team Delegation Hotel
- *Extra Team Officials:*
  - *90 Euros per person, per day, including 3 meals in double room*
  - *120 Euros per person, per day, including 3 meals in single room.*



#### **14. Insurance**

All participants are requested to get their own travel and medical insurance. LOC will provide liability insurance only at the Competition Venue for all participants.

#### **15. Medical Care**

The LOC will provide medical care and first-aid during the entire event to all participants who suffer from a sport injury (contracted during the event).

#### **16. Doping Control**

Doping control shall be conducted in accordance with the AIBA Anti-Doping Rules and following the World Anti-Doping Code under the supervision of the AIBA Medical and Anti-Doping Sub-Commission.

#### **17. Medals**

Gold, Silver and 2 (two) Bronze Medals will be awarded along with diplomas to the winners in each weight category.

#### **18. Training Facility**
