4. Competition Venue

Name: Sports Complex LOK "Vityaz"
Location: Yuzhnij Prospekt, 20, Vityazevo, Anapa

5. Eligibility of Boxer and Weight Category

- A. Boxers who were born between January 1, 1997 – December 31, 1998 are eligible to participate (ages 15 - 16)
- B. The Championships will be staged in 13 Weight Categories:
44kg - 46kg, 48kg, 50kg, 52kg, 54kg, 57kg, 60kg, 63kg, 66kg,
70kg, 75kg, 80kg, 80+kg.

6. Number of Rounds

Three (3) rounds of two (2) minutes, one (1) minute rest between rounds.



7. Scoring System

New AIBA Scoring System, **the 10-Point Must System**, will be used.

8. Referees & Judges

All Referees & Judges (2-3 AIBA Stars only) will be appointed by their respective National Federations.

9. Registration

A. Boxers:

- AIBA National Member Federations can send only one (1) boxer in each weight category and all Boxers must already be registered in AIBA Database.
- One (1) reserve boxer per weight category may be entered in the final registration
- It is also permissible for a Boxer to change his Weight Category and to be replaced by a reserved Boxer, in weight related cases only, at any time up to the closing of the General Weigh-In and Medical Examination.
- All other cases of substitution must be finalized the day before the General Weigh-In, in accordance with the AIBA Technical Rules & AOB Competition Rules.

B. Number of Team Officials:

- Each team can have the following number of officials in its delegation:
 - 1 - 3 boxers: 2 coaches (AIBA Registered) + 1 R&J AIBA 2-3 Star
 - 4 - 7 boxers: 3 coaches (AIBA Registered) + 1 R&J AIBA 2-3 Star
 - 8 - 13 boxers: 4 coaches (AIBA Registered) + 1 R&J AIBA 2-3 Star
- All coaches must be AIBA Certified Coaches and registered in the AIBA Database as EUBC will check each Coach's status at the time of registration. Without the appropriate AIBA certification, Coaches will not be allowed to enter this competition.
- In addition, each team may be accompanied by one (1) Team Manager, one (1) team doctor and one (1) physiotherapist
- Only coaches and boxers will be allowed to enter the boxers' locker rooms.
- Up to three (3) certified Coaches can act as ring Seconds in each Bout.



10. **Requirements**

- A. All Boxers must bring to the General Weigh-In the following documents:
- International AIBA Competition Record Book with an annual medical certificate issued by a Medical Doctor
 - Valid Passport
 - Accreditation Card
- B. Each Team Delegation must bring the following:
- National flag 1x 1.50m
 - National anthem (on MP3 or CD)
- C. Boxer's Uniform:
- Each boxer must bring two sets of uniform – red and blue
 - Boxers must wear a same color set of either red or blue form fitting vest and shorts as per the Boxers' respective corner allocation which will be their own responsibility.
 - The belt line of any shorts must be clearly indicated by a contrasting color and by using a 6-10cm wide elastic waistband (the belt line is an imaginary line from the navel to the top of the hips).

11. **Boxing Equipment**

The LOC will provide AIBA approved and licensed boxing gloves (Adidas), headguards and hand bandages for all boxers and all bouts. Both boxing gloves and headguards are compulsory official items which all boxers must wear as they will not be allowed to wear their personal ones.

12. **Transportation**

- A. Airport or Railway Station Reception:
- All participants will be welcomed at Anapa Airport or Railway Station and the LOC will arrange transportation from Airport to hotels.
 - Team delegations that will arrive/ departure to/from Krasnodar Airport or Railway Station should pay for their transportation to Anapa 20.00 Euro per person each way.
- B. Ground Transportation:
- There will be a welcome desk to guide all teams to the ground transportation
 - The LOC will also provide local transportation for all departures



13. Accommodation for Team Delegations

A. Room Rates for Team Delegations are as follows:

- For single occupancy (1 person per room)
 - 70 Euros per person, per day, including 3 meals
- For double occupancy (2 persons per room)
 - 50 Euros per person, per day, including 3 meals

B. Payment of Hotel Room Charges:

- All delegations must pay the full room charges at the time of arrival in CASH and only in Euros as the Organizing Committee will not be able to accept any other form of payment. The total amount of participants is based on the Final Entry form. If Delegations arrive with a smaller Delegation than previously indicated in the Final Entry and without notification prior to the event, they are still responsible to pay for the difference in full as it is considered a “No Show”
- On arrival, the team delegations must make the full payment for the entire Championships period.
- Team Delegations will not be able to receive accreditation cards and hotel room keys if they do not make the payment in full.

C. Check-In and Check-Out:

- The room rates provided for the competition only apply from November 08 until November 17, 2013
- Team Delegations choosing to arrive earlier and/or stay longer than the Championships Period must pay a room rate of 80.00 Euros per person, per day, including 3 meals in double room and 100.00 Euros per person, per day, including 3 meals in single room.

D. Extra Team Officials:

- No Extra Team Official is allowed to stay at the Team Delegation Hotel(s)
- LOC assistance can only be given in finding rooms in a different hotel than the Team Delegation Hotel(s)
- *Extra Team Officials:*
 - *80.00 Euros per person, per day, including 3 meals in double room*
 - *100.00 Euros per person, per day, including 3 meals in single room.*



14. Insurance

All participants are requested to get their own travel and medical insurance. The LOC will provide liability insurance only at the Competition Venue for all participants.

15. Medical Care

The LOC will provide medical care and first-aid during the entire Championships Period to any participant who suffer from a sport injury contracted during the Championships

16. Doping Control

Doping control will be conducted in accordance with the AIBA Anti-Doping Rules and the World Anti-Doping Code under the supervision of the AIBA Medical and Anti-Doping Sub-Commission.

17. Medals

A gold medal will be awarded to the winner in each Weight Category, a silver medal to the runner-up. Bronze medals will be awarded to both semi-finalists not progressing to the Final in each Weight Category.

18. Training Facility

LOC will provide training facilities from November 8, 2013 (information will be provided to participants upon arrival). The provision of training facilities prior to November 8, 2013 may be requested to LOC, but cannot be guaranteed.

19. Registration

- A. The preliminary registration form must be sent by email at anapa2013@rusboxing.ru **by September 20, 2013**
- B. The final registration form along with the passport copies of all boxers must be sent at anapa2013@rusboxing.ru **by October 20, 2013**

Please note that EUBC will not accept any registration past the Final registration deadline.



20. Visa

The LOC will provide assistance to all Team Delegations on visa matters.

- Team Delegations from countries with a Russian Embassy must apply for visas prior to travelling.
- Team Delegations from countries without Russian Embassy should contact with nearest Consulates in neighbor countries in advance.
- Please send to Boxing Federation of Russia **copies of passports** of all members of your delegation who need Russian visas.
- Although the registration deadline is October 20, it is advisable that Team Delegations send all documents to the Boxing Federation of Russia not later than **October 14, 2013** as after that date, the timely issuance of visas cannot be guaranteed.
